

BARK HOUSE® HOW We Manage The Supply Chain

There were no Bark Vendors before we created this business in 1990, and the subsequent industry.

One of our main business goals was to grow "Self Reliance" by supporting Local Culture and Independently Owned Businesses in the Appalachian area.

When we could no longer supply demand in 1996, we began training local loggers how to procure the material using Best Management Practices.

This was our first step in "Shared Success".

BARK HOUSE® HOW We Manage The Supply Chain

Barking - Best Management Practices

<u>Initial Vendor Preparation</u>

- Vendors are Pro Logger Certified or Forestry School Educated
- Private landowner vendors must be HC trained in BMP
- Vendors strongly encouraged to visit yard for training prior to harvesting
- Due Diligence, Material Use, and W-9's must be completed before material accepted
- Checks are written in the name of person or business that has filled out the forms
- Vendors must accompany first load completely through intake and grading
- Random site audits by HC Inc. are to be expected


BARK HOUSE® HOW We Manage The Supply Chain

Barking - Best Management Practices

Proper Harvesting Techniques

- Detailed specifications sheets for vendors are provided
- Only ring trees at buck lengths
 (ringing shingle lengths will damage log and result in mill refusal)
- Do not over plunge saw for the rip length
 (digging blade into the log may result in mill refusal)
- Grade and cut into shingle lengths or panels in the woods
- Gently flatten bark on truck or trailer with cambium side down (do not allow bark to roll)
- Expedite the peeled bark to our yard within 48 hrs
