Building Products to Make Your House Look Rustic Inside



You can even sheets of birch bark panels to a ceiling with beams (or faux beams).



Corrugated metal is another building material that is a fantastic choice for DIY rustic room creation.

Corrugated panels are available in various finishes, some more rustic looking than others. Depending on the room you are working in, you can add this to ceilings, one wall, all walls, kitchen island bases, shower enclosures... you name it. Hang it horizontally or vertically. This is a very versatile material. Depending on the type of metal you buy, you can let it rust naturally if you would like for a very authentic look.
